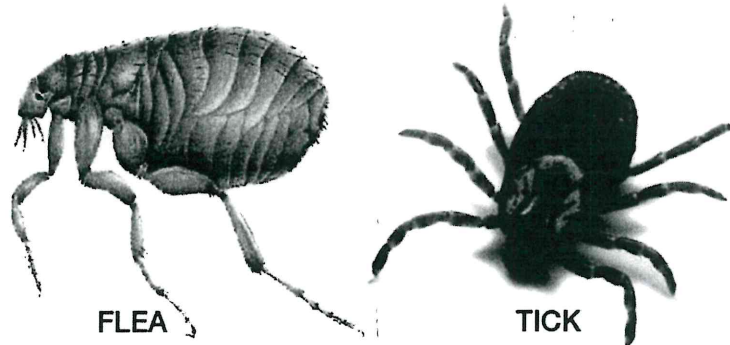




Flea/tick prevention

There are many flea/tick products available, and some work better than others. Your veterinarian may have more products available, but LCHS does have a few options for sale. It is important that your pet be protected against fleas and ticks, as they can transmit several very serious and life threatening diseases and illnesses to your pet.

If you need to purchase flea or heartworm medication, we encourage you to stop by our low cost Vaccine Clinic- they will be able to discuss products with you, and verify that your dog is not currently infected before dispensing any product.



The Vaccine Clinics at LCHS has a variety products for sale for dogs and cats.

Certain flea/tick are not safe for cats- make sure you purchase an appropriate product for your cat.

If you find fleas on one of your pets- all of your pets have them. It is important to treat every animal that comes in the home for 3-4 months in a row. If you only treat for one month, then in 3 months when flea eggs in your carpet are still hatching, they will be attracted to your pet- who is no longer current on flea prevention.

All animals at LCHS are treated for fleas/ticks at intake. If they had live fleas, they were given a Capstar, which kills all live fleas within 30 minutes and lasts 24 hours. All dogs and cats are also given a monthly dose of Revolution, which is a monthly flea/tick and heartworm prevention.
